**Transportation:** To and from the conference will be provided from the Hampton Inn Downtown *only*, via a private shuttle service. Please see [www.go-rts.com](http://www.go-rts.com) for more information on public transit in Gainesville and on the UF campus. Cab services are also available at traveler's expense.

**Airlines:** Gainesville Regional Airport is serviced by Delta and US Air. Other options are 2 hours from Gainesville and accessible rental car or cab, Orlando, Tampa and Jacksonville.

**Directions:** The College of Law is located at 2500 SW 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, on the corner of SW 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and SW 25th Street.

From I-75. From exit 387 (old exit 76), go east approximately 2.75 miles on SR 26 (aka: Newberry Road and University Avenue). Continue just past NW 22nd Street to SW 2nd Avenue; make a right turn at SW 2nd Avenue.

From US 441 (13th Street). Go west approximately 2 miles on SR 26 (University Avenue). Turn left on SW Second Avenue (26A).

From Gainesville Airport. Turn right (west) and go 0.8 miles on NE 39th Ave. to SR 24 West (Waldo Road). Turn left and go approx. 2 1/2 miles to SR 26 (University Ave.). Turn right and go west approx. 2 1/2 miles to SR 26A (SW 2nd Ave.). Turn left at SW 2nd Avenue.

**Event Parking:** Parking is available in the lots directly surrounding the law school buildings and Village Drive (continuation of SW 25th Street heading towards Lake Alice). All parking at the University is decal restricted Monday – Friday. If you wish to park in these lots, you will need to contact Debbie Willis at [willisd@law.ufl.edu](mailto:willisd@law.ufl.edu) to obtain a parking pass and are strongly encouraged to arrive by 8:00am in order to insure a spot. Saturday, parking restrictions are lifted for all decal zones.

**Climate:** Along with plenty of sunshine, temperatures are mild and pleasant. In a typical winter, Gainesville experiences temperatures in the 60s and 70s during the daytime. Sometimes it is 80 degrees. Although winter nights can be cool, there are still very few nights that are freezing. Normal temperatures are in the 40s and the upper 30s. Despite the sunshine, winters are moderately wet, but there is nothing more than a trace of snow that is observed in the city of Gainesville, Florida.
