

UF Law E-Discovery Random Sampler (Beta)

The UF Law E-Discovery Random Sampler application randomly samples the files from the given data folder and copies them to the output folder. Sample Size is determined by the given confidence intervals and confidence levels. This application follows a wizard-based approach for the sampling process. This application was developed by the Computer and Information Science department in association with the Levin College of Law at the University of Florida.

Requirements:

Windows Vista, Windows 7, or Windows 8

The Visual C++ 2008 re-distributable package (vcredist_x86.exe) may need to be installed. It is provided with the installation in the Program Folder (Typically "C:\Program Files(x86)\E-Discovery Random Sampler" or "C:\Program Files\E-Discovery Random Sampler"). Double click vcredist_x86.exe in the Program Folder to execute it.

Execution:

You can double click the desktop short-cut or click on Windows Start Menu -> Programs -> E-Discovery Random Sampler to run the UF Law E-Discovery Random Sampler.
