



# Graduate Internship Opportunity

Bibliographic and Digital Internship for Black Education in Florida, 1920-1955

This semester-long academic internship is available to graduate students.

## Summary of Duties

In partnership with the CSRRL and the UF Smathers Libraries, the intern will support the development and curation of a Fall 2018 exhibit highlighting the legacies of Black educators in Florida.

The intern will be responsible for examining selected UF special collections and compiling an annotated bibliography of materials related to Black educators in Florida, their professional and civic associations, and educational pedagogies.

The intern will generate a bibliography of secondary source materials and provide critical feedback for strengthening existing special collections finding aids and explanatory materials.

Other duties include:

- Researching and assisting in the constructing exhibition labels
- Facilitating collaboration and relationships with other libraries, museums and personal collections with related collection holdings
- Digitizing curator-selected materials for online and traveling exhibitions
