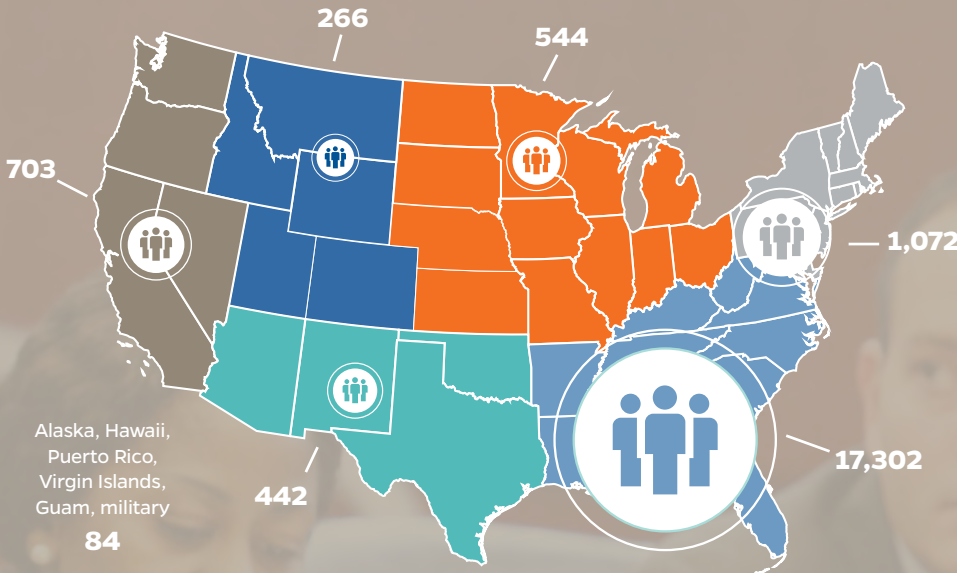

A. Rosenbury completed her first year as the law school's first full-time female dean, and, in the same year, I became the first Cuban-American chair of the board of trustees of the University of Florida Law Center Association.

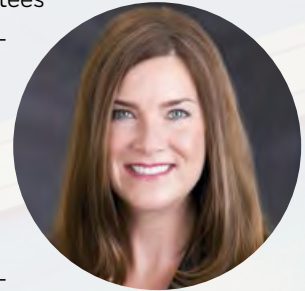

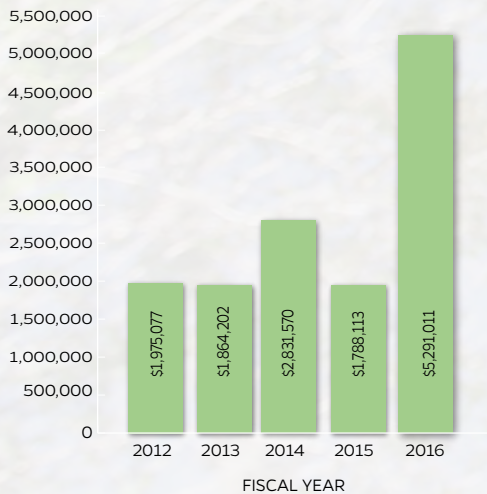

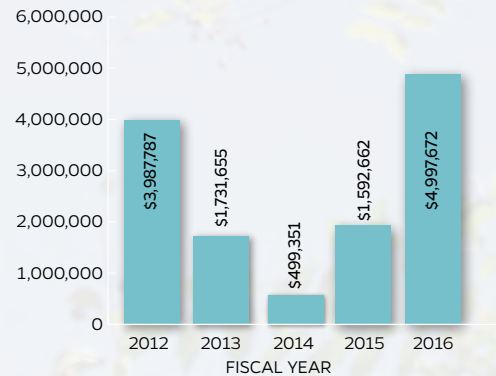

TOTAL CASH RECEIVED



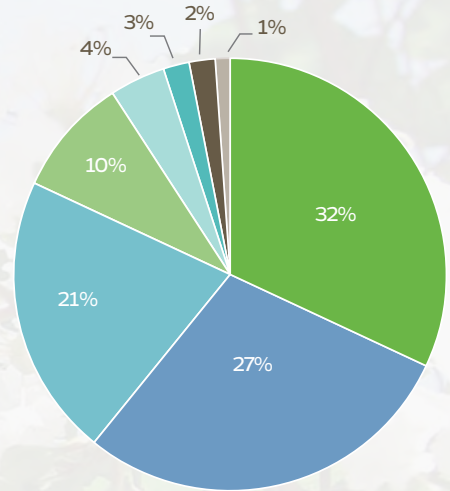
