Dr. W. Kent Fuchs

Dr. Kent Fuchs began serving as Interim President of the University of Florida in August 2024. A professor in the UF Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering, he was the university's 12th president from 2015 to 2023.

Dr. Fuchs led UF into the ranks of the nation's best public universities during his tenure, with the university's stature increasing more than any other research university in the nation. Among other advancements, UF topped \$1 billion in annual research, surpassed \$4.6 billion in philanthropy, and created and filled more than 600 new faculty positions, establishing national prominence in artificial intelligence and other areas of strategic importance.

Previous to the UF presidency, Dr. Fuchs was provost of Cornell University. He also served in academic leadership positions and as a faculty member of electrical and computer engineering at Cornell, Purdue and the University of Illinois.

He has been elected fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, the American Association for the Advancement of Science, the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers and the Association for Computing Machinery and has received numerous awards for teaching and research.

He earned his doctorate in electrical and computer engineering from the University of Illinois, and a Master of Divinity from Trinity Evangelical Divinity School. He also holds a Bachelor of Science in Engineering from Duke University.

Merritt E. McAlister

Levin College of Law Dean

Merritt E. McAlister is the Interim Dean and Levin, Mabie & Levin Professor at Levin College of Law. She joined the UF Law faculty in 2018, and she was appointed interim dean in June 2023. Prior to her career in academia, Dean McAlister was a partner in the national appellate practice group of King & Spalding. While in private practice, she was elected to the American Law Institute, named a Georgia Super Lawyer, and recognized for her pro bono work on civil rights issues.

Dean McAlister clerked for Justice John Paul Stevens of the Supreme Court of the United States and Judge R. Lanier Anderson III of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit. She received her bachelor's degree in English and Women and Gender Studies, magna cum laude, from Rice University and her law degree summa cum laude from the University of Georgia School of Law, where she served as Executive Articles Editor of the Georgia Law Review, and graduated first in her class.

Dean McAlister teaches and writes in the areas of federal courts, judicial decision-making, constitutional law, and court administration. Her scholarship focuses on issues of institutional design in the federal appellate courts. Dean McAlister's work has been published in the University of Pennsylvania Law Review, the Michigan Law Review, and the Northwestern University Law Review, among others. Her 2020 article, "Downright Indifference": Examining Unpublished Decisions in the Federal Courts of Appeals, received the annual prize from the AALS Federal Courts Section for the best paper on federal courts by an untenured professor.

Joseph E. Fluet III (JD 99)

Joseph Fluet is a distinguished American entrepreneur, attorney, corporate leader, philanthropist, and military veteran, well known for his leadership and expertise in national security, aerospace, and legal sectors.

After earning his undergraduate degree from Lehigh University in 1989, Joe was commissioned into the US Army and attended Flight Training, graduating first in his class and joining the 101st Airborne division during the Gulf War. He went on to complete a total of 21 years of active and reserve service. Joe conducted missions all over the world including multiple deployments to Afghanistan, where he created the Afghan Special Mission Wing, the only special operations aviation unit in the Afghan Air Corps.

In 1997, Joe left active duty and earned his Juris Doctor, with High Honors, from the University of Florida Levin College of Law. He served as a judicial clerk for Judge Paul Roney of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit and worked as an attorney at Williams & Connolly LLP. In 2009, he founded Fluet & Huber (now Fluet), a law firm specializing in government contracts, international trade, and corporate law, focusing on clients in national security and intelligence sectors.

In 2010, Joe founded MAG Aerospace, a leading provider of aerial reconnaissance and intelligence services. Under his leadership MAG expanded globally, with thousands of employees operating over 300 aircraft on every populated continent.

Joe also holds executive roles and board positions in numerous public and private organizations, including The Clairvest Group, Top Aces, and Momentum Solutions. Joe is also active in philanthropic activities, serving on the Veteran



Advisory Board of the Concussion Legacy Foundation and the Board of Directors for the International Spy Museum, in addition to managing the Fluet Foundation.

Recognized for his entrepreneurial achievements, Fluet received the EY Entrepreneur of the Year national award in 2017, among numerous other professional accolades. His multifaceted career reflects a commitment to leadership, innovation, and service across national security, legal, and business domains.

Juris Doctor

The Juris Doctor degree is awarded to students who have earned at least a baccalaureate degree, who have completed a three-year course study at the Levin College of Law, and who are recommended by its faculty. The law school recognizes scholastic achievement by awarding the degree of Juris Doctor summa cum laude, magna cum laude, and cum laude based on the following: the top 2% of each graduating class will be awarded the J.D. degree summa cum laude, the next 8.5% of the class will be awarded the degree magna cum laude, and the next 37.5% of the class will be awarded the degree cum laude. Honors designations are as of Fall 2024.
