INFORMATION FOR THE FIRST CLASS

Welcome to Contracts. The required books for the course are:

Textbook: Epstein, Markell and Ponoroff, Cases and Materials on Contracts: Making and Doing Deals (5th ed. 2018).

Supplement: Farnsworth, et al., Selections for Contracts. Either the current or any recent past edition is also acceptable.

Assignment for the first class:

1. Read textbook pages 12-18 and 29-37. This material is introductory. If you wish to get a jump start on the substantive material, the first two cases we will discuss (on day two) are *Lucy v. Zehmer* and *Kolodziej v. Mason*, pages 43-62.
2. Review the two-part syllabus.
3. Read "How Lawyers 'State the Case'" (posted to Canvas "Course Intro & Admin Module).
4. Come to the class with an example of a contract. (This is not a trick question, any simple example will do!)
