Dr. Ben Sasse

Ben Sasse, former U.S. Senator for Nebraska, joined the University of Florida as a professor and 13th president of the 170-year-old institution in February 2023.

A husband, father, historian, Uber driver, and football addict, Ben is committed to guiding Gator Nation through this era of rapid change in the nature of work, technology, and higher education.

A two-time New York Times national best-selling author, Ben's career has spanned the private and public sectors. As a turnaround guy working for the Boston Consulting Group, McKinsey and Company, and private equity firms, Ben has built dozens of teams that built winning strategies.

Having taught at Yale University, the University of Texas, and Midland University in his Nebraska hometown, Professor Sasse has won teaching awards and holds a Doctorate of History from Yale, where his dissertation won both the Egleston and Theron Rockwell Field best dissertation prizes.

In the U.S. Senate, his work on the intelligence, finance, and judiciary committees focused on the future of work, the future of war, and the First Amendment. A sharp critic of our increasing tribalism, he became both the most censured office-holder in the history of Nebraska — and also, by far, the highest vote-getter in the history of Nebraska.

Ben believes in pluralism, free speech, and the power of ideas to build strong and vibrant communities in our digitally disrupted future. In his Senate farewell address, he praised Americans' tradition as "builders" — of churches and synagogues, schools and little leagues, businesses and "the million and one other associations and organizations and clubs and groups through which we live and pass along our life together."

Ben and his wife, Melissa, have two college-age daughters and an 11-year-old son. Ben, Melissa, and Breck live on campus in The Dasburg House with multiple dogs and Breck's iguana, Dart, who is delighted now to call humid subtropical Gainesville home.

Laura Ann Rosenbury

Laura A. Rosenbury is the Dean and Levin, Mabie & Levin Professor of Law at University of Florida Levin College of Law.

Under Dean Rosenbury's leadership, Florida Law has extended its reach around the globe, increased incoming applications by 200%, enrolled eight of the most accomplished and diverse classes in Florida Law's 114-year history, and hired 43 new faculty members. Florida Law has also raised over \$105 million in private funds since 2015, including by conducting the largest and fastest match challenge in UF history, securing a \$20 million gift to endow a health law program – the largest ever gift from a living Florida Law graduate, and coordinating a \$40 million gift from the estate of the college's namesake, Fredric G. Levin. As a result of this focused strategy, Florida Law jumped 27 spots in the *U.S. News & World Report* rankings to #21 in the nation and has solidly ranked among the top 25 law schools in the nation since 2020.

Before joining the Florida Law community, Dean Rosenbury was a professor of law and vice dean at Washington University School of Law in St. Louis. She also has served as a visiting professor at Harvard Law School, Stanford Law School and University of Chicago Law School. Dean Rosenbury's scholarship has been published in the Yale Law Journal, Michigan Law Review, University of Pennsylvania Law Review, Duke Law Journal, and in many other journals and books.

Before entering academia in 2002, Dean Rosenbury worked as a litigation associate at Davis Polk & Wardwell in New York City and clerked for Judge Carol Bagley Amon of the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of New York and Judge Dennis Jacobs of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit. Dean Rosenbury received her A.B. summa cum laude in women's studies from Harvard-Radcliffe College and her J.D. cum laude from Harvard Law School, where she served as a primary editor of the Harvard Law Review.

Dean Rosenbury will become the ninth president of Barnard College at Columbia University this summer.

The Hon. Joe Scarborough (JD 90)


Former Congressman Joe Scarborough (R-Fla.) is co-host of MSNBC's "Morning Joe" alongside Mika Brzezinski - a show with a reported increased viewership of 113% by Variety. "Morning Joe" starts each weekday conducting interviews with top newsmakers and discussing the day's headlines. The New York Times ranked Morning Joe as one of today's top morning news shows and has praised Joe and Mika's natural repartee and off-the-cuff commentary. The New Yorker also described the show as "appallingly entertaining." In 2016, Joe, joined by co-host Mika, was inducted into the Cable Hall of Fame.

In 2022, Morning Joe celebrated 15 years on air with the debut of the show's expansion to four hours of programming every weekday. While it may be newer for West Coast audiences, the four-hour program now sets Morning Joe's co-anchor team of Joe, Mika Brzezinski and Willie Geist as the longest running anchor team in cable television news programming.

Joe was named to the prestigious "Time 100" list of the world's most influential people, and Vanity Fair named both Joe and Mika to their 2012 list of "Top Media Power Players."

In addition to his television career, Joe is a two-time New York Times best-selling author. His first work, "Rome Wasn't Burnt in a Day," predicted the collapse of the Republican majority and U.S. economy due to his party's reckless spending. His second work, "The Last Best Hope: Restoring Conservatism and America's Promise," draws on the forgotten genius of conservatism to offer a road map for the movement and the country. Joe also frequently contributes political opinion pieces to The Washington Post.

Joe's most recent publication, "Saving Freedom: Truman, The Cold War, and the Fight for Western



Civilization," recounts the historic forces that moved Truman toward his country's long twilight struggle against Soviet communism. Truman's triumph over the personal and political struggles that confronted him following his ascension to the presidency is an inspiring tale of American leadership, fierce determination, bipartisan unity, and courage in the face of rising Soviet threat.

Joe served as a member of Congress from 1994-2001. While in office, he was a member of the Judiciary, Armed Services, Oversight, and National Security Committees.



Doctor of Juridical Science in Taxation

The S.J.D. degree is an advanced degree for students who have already attained a Juris Doctor (J.D.) degree, or in the case of international students, attained an equivalent law degree from a university outside the United States. The S.J.D. degree is awarded to students who complete the College's requirements, which include writing a monograph of publishable quality. Students are recommended for the degree by the faculty of the Levin College of Law.

The LL.M. in International Taxation degree is awarded to students who complete Levin College of Law requirements (including a substantial research paper and a minimum of 13 credits in international taxation courses) and have earned a Juris Doctor (J.D.) degree, or in the case of international students, a law degree from a university outside the United States. Students are recommended for the degree by the faculty of the Levin College of Law. A student who obtains the LL.M. in Taxation degree is not eligible to obtain the LL.M. in International Taxation degree.

Juris Doctor

The Juris Doctor degree is awarded to students who have earned at least a baccalaureate degree, who have completed a three-year course study at the Levin College of Law, and who are recommended by its faculty. The degree is awarded with Honors to those with a grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.3 (on a four point scale), with High Honors to those with a GPA of at least 3.7 and with Highest Honors to those with a GPA of at least a 3.9.
