Ben Sasse joined the University of Florida as a professor and 13th president of the 170-year-old institution in February 2023.

A husband, father, historian, Uber driver, and football addict, Ben is committed to guiding Gator Nation through this era of rapid change in the nature of work, technology, and higher education.

As the leader of Florida's flagship land-grant university, Ben has moved swiftly to cultivate fresh leadership, construct a UF-wide strategic planning initiative, and ground UF's priorities in making the highest and best use of public funds. He has sought to establish goals that are critical to Gators and the state: more applied research, more focus on lifelong learning for students, and faster, more nimble engagement with exceptional partners.

Ben believes that Florida is the most dynamic state in the Union — with a diverse economy, fast-growing population, and vast outside investment. He sees UF as uniquely positioned to help Floridians maximize the state's potential as an economic and cultural juggernaut.

Twice elected to the United States Senate and a two-time *New York Times* national best-selling author, Ben's career has spanned the private and public sectors.

Passionate about education and teaching, Ben taught at Yale University, the University of Texas, and Midland University in his Nebraska hometown. Professor Sasse has won teaching awards and holds a history Ph.D. from Yale, where his dissertation won both the Egleston and Theron Rockwell Field best dissertation prizes.

Merritt E. McAlister

Merritt E. McAlister

Merritt E. McAlister is the Interim Dean and Levin, Mabie & Levin Professor of Law at University of Florida Levin College of Law. Dean McAlister is an award-winning federal courts scholar, who focuses on issues of institutional design in the federal appellate courts. Her work has been published in the *Michigan Law Review*, *University of Pennsylvania Law Review*, and in the *Northwestern Law Review*, among others.

Dean McAlister became the interim dean of Florida Law in June 2023. Since that time, she has developed a comprehensive academic success strategy for the College, recruited one of the most talented and diverse entering classes in Florida Law history, and hired one of the nation's leading administrative law scholars to join the Florida Law faculty.

Before joining the Florida Law community, Dean McAlister was a partner in the national appellate practice at King & Spalding in Atlanta. Before that, she served as law clerk to Justice John Paul Stevens of the Supreme Court of the United States and Judge R. Lanier Anderson III on the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit. Dean McAlister earned her bachelor's degree magna cum laude from Rice University and her J.D. summa cum laude from the University of Georgia School of Law, where she was the First Honors Graduate and the Executive Article Editor of the *Georgia Law Review*.

NORTH CAROLINA SUPREME COURT JUSTICE ALLISON RIGGS (JD 09)

Justice Allison Riggs was honored to be appointed by Governor Roy Cooper to serve on the North Carolina Supreme Court in September of 2023. She previously served on the North Carolina Court of Appeals. Since her appointment, she has been campaigning at full speed to run in November 2024 for a full term on the court.

Justice Riggs spent her entire career fighting for equal justice under the law for every person, regardless of wealth or skin color. Prior to her appointment to the North Carolina Court of Appeals and then the North Carolina Supreme Court, she served as Co-Executive Director for Programs and Chief Counsel for Voting Rights at the Southern Coalition for Social Justice (“SCSJ”) in Durham. During her 14 years of practice at SCSJ, she had the privilege of advocating for those who had been marginalized and lacked access to legal resources. She not only represented grassroots organizations in courtrooms, arguing before the U.S. Supreme Court in multiple benchmark redistricting cases; she also worked with these groups to ensure they had the communications, organizing, and research tools needed to advocate for structural change even outside the courtroom. In her civil rights practice, Justice Riggs fought gerrymandering and voter suppression, environmental injustice, and worked with partners on criminal justice reform.

Justice Riggs’ passion for justice led her to transition from working in front of the bench to working behind it because she knows that the promise of equal justice under law requires electing judges whose first commitment is to the United States and North Carolina constitutions and to doing right by the people of this state. She appreciates the history of her appointment: she is the youngest woman to ever serve on the NC Supreme Court and the only woman of child-bearing age on the entire appellate judiciary.

Her time on the Court of Appeals proved she can be effective, even when significantly outnumbered politically. Then-Judge Riggs drafted nearly 50 opinions in her time on the Court of Appeals. She delivered just results in cases ranging from interpreting public records laws to ensuring that victims of child sex abuse could seek accountability for all who harmed them.



Justice Riggs approaches all the cases that have and will come before her with thoughtfulness, compassion, and a commitment to the rule of law. As a justice, her guiding principles are integrity, transparency, consistency, and empathy. Justice Riggs knows that a legal system that creates unnecessary hurdles or wrongfully cuts off access for injured people is a system that will not garner trust or respect. She takes seriously her role in making sure our judicial system is accessible and well understood by all North Carolinians. Justice Riggs earned her Bachelor’s degree, Master’s degree, and Juris Doctor from the University of Florida. In addition to her practice and her service on the bench, she has devoted herself to serving the community and her profession through associations ranging from the North Carolina Bar Association to the American Constitution Society.

Doctor of Juridical Science in Taxation

The S.J.D. degree is an advanced degree for students who have already attained a Juris Doctor (J.D.) degree, or in the case of international students, attained an equivalent law degree from a university outside the United States. The S.J.D. degree is awarded to students who complete the College's requirements, which include writing a monograph of publishable quality. Students are recommended for the degree by the faculty of the Levin College of Law.

A student who obtains the LL.M. in Taxation degree is not eligible to obtain the LL.M. in International Taxation degree.
